- **To help with cost for teams**, teams are invited to share a campsite with another team. We may have to cap the backyard teams to 30 only if a small number of campsites are available. We also have grassy area near turn-in tent and in the camping/tent area – teams will have to carry water and limited electricity hook ups – no charge in grassy areas.
- **Teams are invited to complete in one or both days of the backyard competition**

Entry Fee is \$150.00 each day. W9 Form - Please complete and send in a W-9 form along with your registration and money. Prize money will not be given to a winning team if team has not turned in a completed (signed/dated) W-9 form and/or paid the entry fee by the end of Friday, June 10th.

Turn-In Times: Saturday - 2:30 pm (chicken) & 3:00 pm (pork ribs); Sunday- 11 am (chicken) & 11:30 am (pork ribs).

Prizes

Each backyard team is required to cook both chicken and pork ribs to win the Grand Champion and the Reserve Grand Champion Awards. Prize money of \$3000 for both days will be awarded as follows:

Awards will be presented on or close to 4:30 pm on Saturday and approximately 3:00 pm on Sunday.

KCBS Rules Apply. All teams must follow the **2022 KCBS Backyard Official Rules and Regulations for Backyard Contests** and the **2022 KCBS Updated Emergency COVID-19 Procedures**, except turn-in times. Please review the rules on the KCBS.us.

Cooks' Meeting. The cooks' mandatory meeting for backyard teams, master series teams, and Kids Que cooks are on Friday, June 10th at 4:00 pm and if a backyard team cannot make the meeting on Friday, there will be a cooks' meeting on Saturday, June 11th at 8:00 am next to or in the tent. If a team cannot make the meeting, they need to connect with the Reps on late Friday or early Saturday before turn-in times.

Styrofoam Numbered Boxes will be given out to teams on Friday (available all day) or Saturday at cooks' meeting.

Meat Inspection. You will need to follow the meat inspection rules in the **2022 KCBS Backyard Official Rules and Regulations for Backyard Contests**. Meat inspection will start on Friday morning for the Saturday backyard competition. If competing in the Backyard on Sunday, meat inspections will be done Saturday morning. If you are not able to be at the

campground on Friday, meat inspection will take place on Saturday morning from 6 – 8 am. No meats shall be marinated, brined, or injected prior to meat inspection; you can trim the meats only. And meat is not allowed to leave the campground after the meat has been checked/approved.

Optional Competitions:

- **Anything BACON Competition** is on Friday (6/10) – Regular Cut Bacon will be provided by Compart Family Farms.
 - Cook must provide enough for 6 judges; can be put in a numbered Styrofoam container from KCBS Rep, or number cut from the Styrofoam container and taped on a platter with 6 individual plates/bowls, etc.
 - Payout: \$150 – 1st, \$100 – 2nd, and \$50 for 3rd place.
 - One entry per cook or team member.
 - **Organizer's Choice** – if a cook wishes to include their entry in the Anything BACON Organizer's Choice, cooks need to provide enough samples for 3 judges and handed separately to the organizer's helper at the turn-in table; must have the number given by KCBS rep on the Styrofoam box or cut and taped number on a platter with the 3 individual plates/bowls. Payout \$50.
 - Turn-in time is Friday at 7 pm; if time changes, we will announce at cooks' meeting
 - Awards at 8 pm.

Cooking/Camping Sites.

- **Neshonoc Lakeside Camp/Resort at 608-786-1792. Resort requests all teams to contact organizers first before contacting resort to reserve a campsite. For map of campground and fun activities, go to rvonthego.com.**
- Resort has two pump stations.
- Hotels (Sponsor for BHTB judges and teams): Holiday Inn Express & Suites (Onalaska/La Crosse) 608-667-3030; \$99/night; blocked rooms under Bring'n Home the Bacon.
- Campsite fees are separate from competition fees.
- If you wish to rent a **golf cart** – please contact Neshonoc Lakeside Camp/Resort; golf carts are limited.
- Teams may come to the campground and set up as early in the week as they wish. **If team plans on coming Friday after 9 pm, please let the organizer know your estimated time of arrival on the entry form.**
- **Chief Cook takes responsibility for team conduct and to keep cooking site clean during and after the contest.**
- Pits, cookers, campers, tents, and other equipment shall not exceed the assigned camping site.
- **A fire extinguisher must be near all cooking devices.**
- Bring your own extension cords, connection hoses, and electrical adapters.
- Security will be available for the entire area provided by the Neshonoc Lakeside Camp – Resort.
- Quiet times are from 11 pm to 7 am per the Neshonoc Lakeside Camp Resort Rules

Water & Electricity. Water, 30 and 50 amp, and 110v outlets are provided on all campsites.

Ice. Ice will be available at the Neshonoc Lakeside Camp-Resort.

Restrooms & Showers. There are 2 sets of restrooms, showers and laundry buildings in the camping area. We will have a few port-a-potties stationed around campground.

Trash / Hot Ash / Grease

Our team and the Neshonoc Lakeside Camp-Resort staff will be coming around your site periodically to pick up your trash. Hot coals can be placed in your firepit. There will be grease containers throughout the sites for your grease.
